#### THIRD AMENDMENT TO MASTER DEED

## Ledgestone

(Act 59, Public Acts of 1978) as amended

THIS THIRD AMENDMENT TO MASTER DEED is made this 27th day of October, 2010, by Ledgestone Condominium Association, a Michigan non-profit corporation that acts as the association of co-owners of Ledgestone (the "Association"), whose address is 2562 Breton Creek Drive, SE, Kentwood, MI 49512, as represented herein, by Amy J. Preston, its President and Cindy Szotko its Secretary, who are fully empowered and qualified to act on behalf of the corporation.

WHEREAS, Ledgestone is a residential condominium project (the "Project") established by Master Deed recorded October 28, 2004 with the Kent County Register of Deeds as Document No. 20041028-0142891, as amended by First Amendment to Master Deed recorded October 3, 2006 with the Kent County Register of Deeds as Document No. 20061003-0109530, and as amended by Second Amendment to Master Deed recorded October 15, 2007, with the Kent County Register of Deeds as Document No. 20071015-010075 (together, "Master Deed"); and

WHEREAS, the last few years have been a difficult economic times for the Developer and the Developer has requested an extension of time for the exercise of its reserved rights under Article VII of the Master Deed. The Association desires to extend the term by which Developer may make modifications to the Project by an additional period of time in order to facilitate the orderly development of the Project, and the Association has obtained the consent of more than two-thirds (2/3) of the Co-owners of the Project to the proposed amendment.

NOW THEREFORE, the Association does hereby amend the Master Deed as follows:

- Modification of Time Periods for Exercise of Reserved Rights. The time periods set 1. forth in Article VII of the Master Deed for the exercise of the Developer's rights to expand, contract, add after contraction, or convert areas of the Project, and all related rights under Article VII, are hereby extended until December 31, 2013.
- Continuing Effect. Except as amended herein, the provisions of the Master Deed 2. of Ledgestone, as amended by First and Second Amendments to Master Deed, recorded in the Office of the Register of Deeds for Kent County, Michigan, as Condominium Subdivision Plan No. 691, are hereby ratified and confirmed.
